The large horn with MCT (Multicell Transformer), which can be rotated for array operation, offers precise dispersion alongside even and defined coverage and helps to reduce listening fatigue. It can be flown as a single unit or with up to four cabinets in a horizontal array at any angle. Filter presets for Lab.Gruppen and Powersoft offer acoustically ideal tuning of the speakers for clusters of one to four or in combination with CONTOUR or COSMO systems, ensuring that the Concert 2.0 philosophy is realized.
